Short Description:

The video dance installation '*Relationscapes, an exercise on waiting*' is **an exercise on waiting for both the performer of the video and the viewer.** By engaging with the state of stillness, the performer listens to the surrounding environment, and is in a constant relation with the stimulus coming from it; the air, the space, the sound, the ground. The state of stillness is transformed into the state of waiting through the form of video and the modalities of editing. The time is expanded. The linear perception of time is triggered. The viewer is invited to take time, observe, slow down the rhythm of her/his breath, get bored, contemplate, observe micromovements, and experience the artwork through her thinking and sensorial body.

Physical stories,

Technical Aspect of the artwork

The editing of the video focuses on modalities/techniques which trigger the way that the viewer experiences time. The soundscape of the piece has been composed for headphones. Audience lays down on the floor, attends the video while listening to the soundscape through headphones. In that way, the context is created which allows the viewer to relax, calm down, slow down her/his perception of time, experience and engage with the artwork through her/his/@ sensorial body.

So, the set of the video-performance installation consists of:

- Video displayed in the ceiling of a performing/gallery space.
- Pillows, soft materials, where the audience can lay down on them.
- A few headphones, where the audience can use them and listen to the soundscape while watching the video.
